Dr Gail Byrne

As a psychologist Gail operates a private consultancy specialising in the IQ assessment of children and adolescents and consults to a number of schools about their testing programs and the identification and management of exceptional children who may be challenging and complex and need individual education programs developed.

Gail's involvement in the gifted field started some 20 years ago. She has been involved with the CHIP Foundation since 1989 and was elected Chairperson in 2001, a role she still holds.

After completing a Master of Education (1992) in curriculum differentiation, and a Graduate Diploma in Counselling (1995), Gail was awarded a Doctorate in Psychology in 2002 for her research into the levels of academic achievement and underachievement in a group of 50 children with IQs ranging between 125 and 200.

Gail is sought after as a speaker on giftedness, underachievement and testing; has completed a DEET project on giftedness and has authored a number of papers on exceptional children.

As a registered psychologist, practising teacher and parent of two gifted children (now adults) she has developed a quite unique understanding of intellectual giftedness.
